You are welcome to gather supplies (itemized below) for families in Harlan County, Kentucky affected by the Black Jewell layoffs and refusal to pay miners. A collection point has been set up in the parking lot of Historic Saint Paul Church on West Short Street, next to the Opera this Saturday from 9 am until 1 pm.

These workers are protesting because they have not received payment for almost 2 months of work and have learned via social media that their employer has filed bankruptcy and is withholding their rightfully earned wages.

The struggle these families are going through day to day is

troubling. With the start of school just days away, many of these families are now struggling to put food on the table let alone try and purchase school supplies. The specific items you are asked to donate are:

- non-perishable food
- toiletry items
- school supplies for children
- laundry detergent, cleaning supplies, bleach
